Clean Install of SurvCE:

Step #1) Back up your serial number and equipment settings:

- 1) Backup all your Job Files to a desktop or laptop computer
- 2) Run SurvCE and go into Equip / About SurvCE / Change Registration = write down your
- 4) SurvCE Serial Number and Change Key
- 3) Then go into Equip / Total Station and GPS Base / GPS Rover to record all your current
- 5) instrument settings being used for GPS in Current, Comms, Receiver, RTK, and all your Total Station settings in Current, Comms, Settings, Inst, Search, etc.
- 6) Tap Equip / Configure and Equip / Tolerances and jot down any of these settings that look important to you

Step # 2) Rename the existing Carlson SurvCE folder:

- 1) Tap file then tap Exit and tap "YES" to exit SurvCE
- 2) Tap Start / Programs / File Explorer
- Tap whatever folder name is shown in the upper left just below the Start menu then tap on DEVICE
- 4) Tap "Program Files" then tap "SurvCE"
- 5) Tap and hold on the "SurvStar" folder to get a popup right-click menu then tap "Rename"
- 6) Tap behind "SurvStar" and type in "**OLD**" without the quotes so the new folder name is "SurvStarOLD" then hit ENTER
- 7) The folder should now show as "SurvStarOLD" in your list

Step #3) Install SurvCE using the steps below:

- 1) Download SurvCE for your data collector from our website.
 - A) Carlson SurvCE Download Page
 - B) Change the product version to the version that you own
 - C) Enter your SurvCE serial number, and then click Show Files to access the list of downloads.
- 2) **PLUG in the USB cable** from your Data Collector to your Desktop or Laptop computer to get connected with ActiveSync.

If you have Windows XP and need to install ActiveSync click the link below. After it downloads click "Run" and then Follow the On-Screen prompts to install it:

- 3) On the Data Collector Tap File & Exit to make sure you exit out of SurvCE before the Install if you are already running a previous version of SurvCE.
- 4) On the Desktop PC Double click the SurvCE file that you downloaded in Step 1. Click Run / Next / Click I Accept / Click Install / Click yes to Re-Install.

- 5) Let the status bar go across on the Desktop PC and Click OK when it prompts "Please Check Mobile Device" then **Click Finish** on the Desktop PC.
- 6) On the Data Collector Tap OK if it asks you to "Remove the Previous Version"
- 7) Tap "Install" in the bottom left on the Data Collector to install SurvCE
- 8) Once the Status Bar finishes on the data collector it will say "Carlson Software was successfully installed" --- you can Tap OK in the upper right
- 9) To verify that you are now on the latest version --- Open SurvCE / tap the Equip Tab / Tap About SurvCE: Check to see that the version and date on the top match what you downloaded {i.e. -Version 2.62} tap Close after you check your version.
- 10) This completes the upgrade / install of SurvCE
