

## How To Transfer Data from SurvCE Onboard To A USB Thumb Drive

- 1. Create a folder in your USB Flash Memory drive such as "USB DATA", while its connected to your computer
- 2. Insert the USB thumbdrive into the Surveyor data collector
- 3. Open the Job that you are working on in SurvCE
- 4. Tap File / Data Transfer



5. Tap "Set Storage"
