

- 1. Activate your WIFI hotspot on your phone. It is likely your phone will require that you set a password, to be used by mobile devices, which will connect to your phone.
- 2. Exit it out of SurvCE, by going to File. Then, Exit.



3. Tap on the **Wifi** icon, on the desktop of the data collector, to activate Wifi. It will turn red when it is available for establishing a connection.

4. Tap on the **Connections** icon.



5. Tap the Wi-Fi icon.

6. Find your phone in the list of available Wi-Fi devices. If you do not see your phone listed Tap on Add New.



- 7. On the **Configure Wireless Network** screen, set **Connects to: The Internet.**
- 8. **Do Not** check the box for "This is a hidden network". Then, tap **Next**.

- 9. On the Configure Network Authentication screen, set Authentication to WPA2-PSK.
- 10. Set Data Encryption to **AES**.
- 11. The Network key will be the **password**, which you had set on your phone.
- 12. Then, tap Next.
