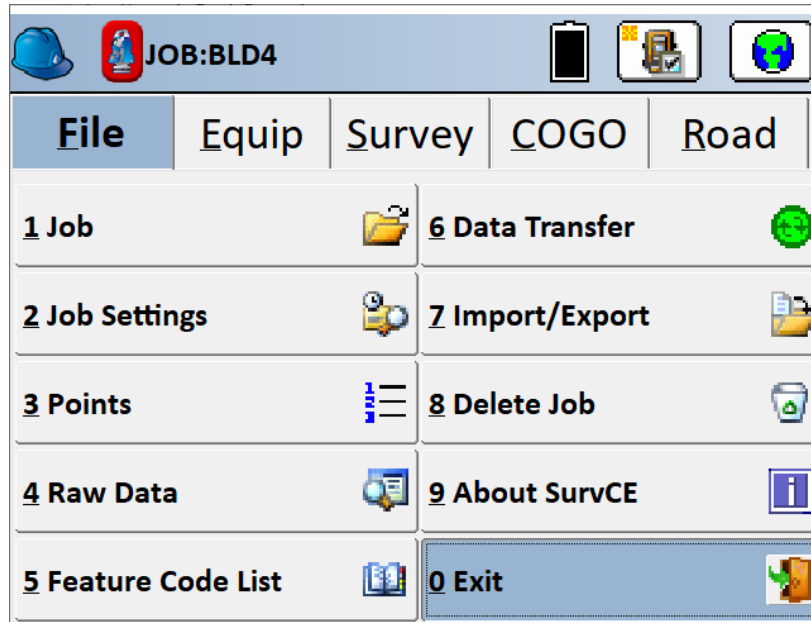


1. Activate your WIFI hotspot on your phone. It is likely your phone will require that you set a password, to be used by mobile devices, which will connect to your phone.
2. **Exit it out of SurvCE**, by going to File. Then, **Exit**.



3. Tap on the **Wifi** icon, on the desktop of the data collector, to activate Wifi. It will turn red when it is available for establishing a connection.



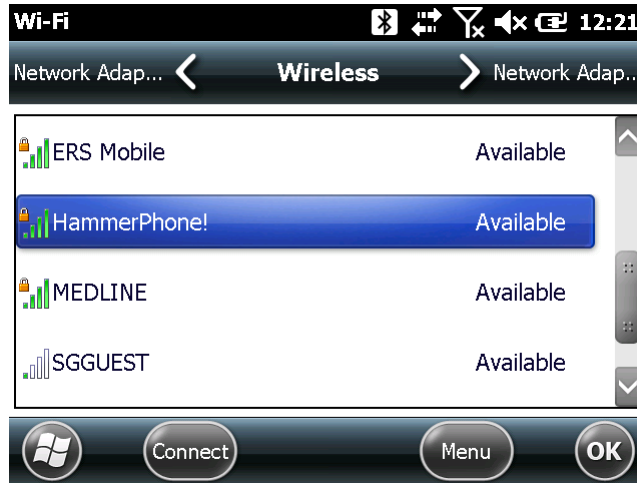
4. Tap on the **Connections** icon.



5. Tap the **Wi-Fi** icon.



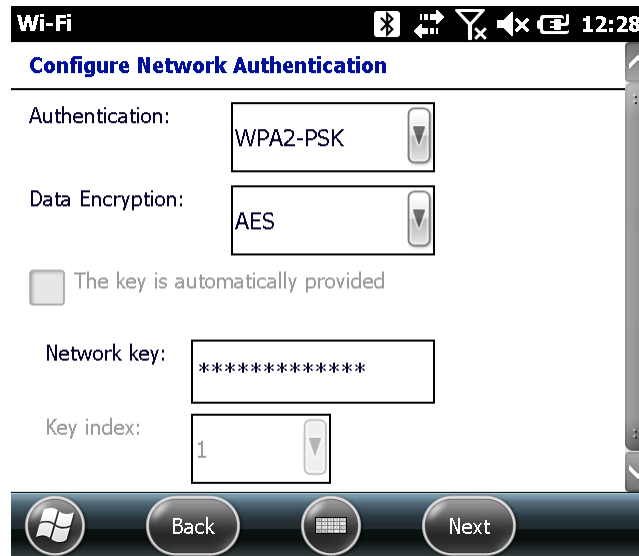
- Find your phone in the list of available Wi-Fi devices. If you do not see your phone listed Tap on Add New.



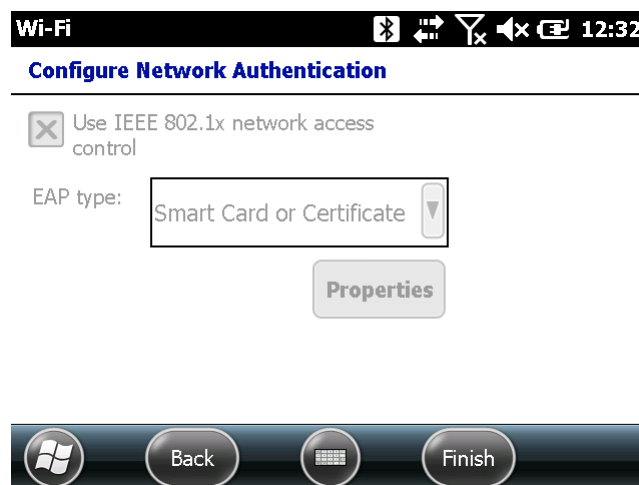
- On the **Configure Wireless Network** screen, set **Connects to: The Internet**.
- Do Not** check the box for "This is a hidden network". Then, tap **Next**.



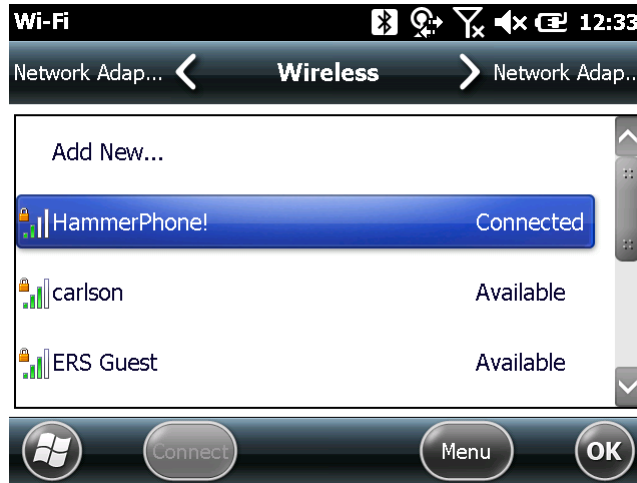
9. On the Configure Network Authentication screen, set Authentication to **WPA2-PSK**.
10. Set Data Encryption to **AES**.
11. The Network key will be the **password**, which you had set on your phone.
12. Then, tap **Next**.



13. On the next Configure Network Authentication screen, tap **Finish**.



14. When the connection has been established the data collector will show “Connected.” Tap **OK**. Then, tap **X** to return to the data collector’s desktop.



15. The Wifi icon on the desktop should now be blue, and show your phone as it's connection.
