

## How do I use my 2007 toolbars in 2008?

If you have custom toolbars in 2007 that you would like to use in 2008 you will need to transfer the toolbars from the old 2007 CUI file to the new 2008 CUI file. Here are the steps to make the transfer:

- You first need to copy any custom bitmaps you have created in 07 to the 08 directory for them to be used. Typically the directory for the bitmaps is C:\PROGRAM FILES\CARLSON SOFTWARE 200#\SUPPORT. You can copy all bitmaps from 2007 support file and paste into 2008 support file and when prompted to overwrite, select no to all and only your new custom bitmaps will be added.
- Next you need to access the cui editor in Carlson Survey 2008 by typing CUI on the command line. Once the editor appears select the “Transfer”(1) tab at the top. You will now see the current 2008 CUI file loaded on the left side. You need to load the 2007 cui file on the right side by selecting the folder icon (2). C:\Program Files\Carlson Software 2007\UserDataCache\Support should be the path for the old CUI. Once loaded you can expand out “Toolbars” and expand out the toolbar that has your custom button on it. You can then drag and drop the command from the old CUI to the new one on the left (3). You can drag either one command or you can drag a entire toolbar if you have created one.
