How to turn off the Windows 7 Automatic update on the Supervisor

- **1.** Turn on the Supervisor.
- 2. Tap on the Start symbol in the bottom left then tap Control Panel
- In the upper right open the View By pull-down and tap Large Icons.

- **6.** Tap on the drop down box in the center of the screen. It probably says "Install updates automatically".
- 7. Tap on the third choice in the box which is "Check for updates but let me choose whether to download and install them".
