- 2. Insert the USB thumb drive into the Supervisor tablet.
- 3. Open the Job or start a new Job where you want the points loaded into


7. Tap on the Text file that you wish to import. Then, tap the Green Check.



8. In the center of the Import ASCII screen, there is a preview window. This window shows a brief preview of the data which you are about to import. Please note whether the data is separated by commas or spaces. This is important, as you will need to tell the program exactly which format it will be reading to import the points.

- 10. You now be prompted to select the .crd file, into which the points will be imported.



11. Select your CRD file, and then click to green checkmark to import the text file.
